- College transcripts (official or "released to student")
- Two letters of recommendation
- Resumé

We are currently asking that letters of recommendation be submitted by your recommender using our online system. You should contact the people writing your letters of recommendation to make sure they have heard from us after you complete this online application form. If they do not wish to use the online system, signed letters of recommendation on letterhead may be sent as PDFs by email to Dr. Michael Allen (mallen@mdsg.umd.edu) or hard copies by regular mail to Dr. Michael Allen, Maryland Sea Grant College, 4321 Hartwick Road, Suite 300, University of Maryland, College Park, Maryland 20740.

The rest of the additional required materials listed above may be submitted using our online system to upload electronic PDF versions of your statement of interest, transcripts (if available in electronic format), and resumé. If you do not have electronic versions of your transcripts, please have them sent to Dr. Michael Allen at the address above. These may be official or "unofficial released to student" versions of your transcripts.
