

Louisiana's Coastal Master Plan (Large-scale = Expensive Projects)

- First approved in 2007 – 50\$B plan to be implemented over 50 years.
- To date implements 134 projects ~ \$13.2B
- Plan updated every 5 years


Ingredients of Success

- State Priority: stakeholder support, reoccurring disasters
- Governance Structure
- All Inclusive- Everyone has a roll



Comprehensive Everglades Restoration Program (Separable Elements Connect for Large Effect)

- Authorized in 2000, 60 projects to be completed by 2030 for a total cost of \$8.2B
- As of FY2022 spent \$8.8B (\$3.5B Fed, \$5.3B Florida). Have completed 24 of the 68 projects.
- Now Expected to cost \$23.2B to be completed by 2050





Ingredients of Success
